ne of the most important callings that God gives Ignite Bands first launched several years ago when a few Dawson Music Academy instructors had a vision to invest in the next generation of worship leaders. After prayerfully exploring several different ideas, the instructors created Ignite Bands. The name "Ignite" reflects the goal of the bands: to "ignite" a love for music, a connection with other musicians, and a passion to lead in worship.

> In keeping with our commitment to invest in the next generation, Ignite Bands provide opportunities for young musicians, ranging from elementary-age to high school, to explore their talents with other musicians. Each Ignite Band includes a small group of 4-8 band members of similar age and ability level. In weekly sessions, vocalists, guitarists, keyboardists, and drummers come together to rehearse worship songs. Students and coaches create the playlist of worship songs each semester.
